Second call for Papers Submission Deadline: 15th September 2023

This fourth CSEAR Ireland conference aims to bring together scholars and practitioners interested in issues related to Social and Environmental Accounting Research. The spirit of the conference is collegiate and inter-disciplinary, and we aim to provide a forum for discussion, collaboration and intellectual exchange for all those interested in any of these fields of research or practice. The conference is hosted by the Department of Accounting at Queen's Management School in Belfast and the theme of the conference is the "Role of Sustainability Accounting, Accountability and Governance in Transitioning Towards the Sustainable Development Goals".

An early career workshop on "Perspectives on the Publication Process" will also be held on the afternoon of 8th November 2023.

Plenary speaker

We are delighted to announce that our confirmed plenary conference keynote speaker is Professor Leonardo Rinaldi from Royal Holloway University, London.

Practitioners' forum

During the conference there will be a practitioner forum titled "Accounting for SDGs transition in different settings: challenges and opportunities". The aim of the session is to open up a discussion and debate with representatives from the not for profit, private and public sector – on the main challenges and opportunities faced by the practitioners in transitioning towards the SDGs.

Submission procedure

We welcome abstracts of 500 words or more on this or on the broader themes of social and environmental accounting research. In keeping with the traditions of CSEAR, we invite diverse methodological approaches and interdisciplinary work that contributes to our understanding of social and environmental accounting, and the societal impact of accounting, accountability and governance.
